1 BUSINESS MEETING ON PENDING NOMINATIONS 2 _ _ _ 3 TUESDAY, JULY 31, 2018 4 United States Senate, 5 Committee on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry, 6 Washington, D.C. 7 The committee met, pursuant to notice, at 2:21 p.m., in 8 Room S-216, The Capitol, Hon. Pat Roberts, Chairman of the 9 Committee, presiding. 10 Present or submitting a statement: Senators Roberts, 11 Boozman, Hoeven, Ernst, Grassley, Thune, Daines, Stabenow, 12 Brown, Klobuchar, Bennet, Gillibrand, Heitkamp, Casey, and 13 Smith. 14 OPENING STATEMENT OF CHAIRMAN ROBERTS Chairman Roberts. I now call to order a business 15 16 meeting of the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Nutrition, 17 and Forestry. 18 The purpose of this meeting is to consider two 19 nominations: Dan Berkovitz, to serve as a Commissioner of 20 the Commodity Futures Trading Commission; and James Hubbard 21 to serve as the Under Secretary for Natural Resources and 22 Environment for the Department of Agriculture. 23 Mr. Berkovitz has shown his significant experience as a 24 partner at the law firm Wilmer Hale, co-chairing the firm's 25 futures and derivatives practices, and tenure as CFTC's

1 general counsel for the CFTC, writing rules and regulations
2 to implement Dodd Frank. Despite that, he will be a major
3 asset to the CFTC and our end-users.

Mr. Hubbard's dedication to public service, including 5 35 years in the Colorado Forest Service, and serving in 6 management positions at both the Department of Interior and 7 then the U.S. Forest Service, will serve him well to lead 8 the NRE mission area.

9 I fully support these nominations.

10 I now recognize the Ranking Member for any comments she 11 may have.

12 OPENING STATEMENT OF SENATOR STABENOW 13 Senator Stabenow. I simply move that we proceed with 14 confirming both these nominees.

15 Chairman Roberts. A motion would now be in order to 16 approve the nominations of Dan Berkovitz to be a 17 Commissioner of the CFTC, and James Hubbard to serve as the 18 Under Secretary of Natural Resources and Environment at 19 USDA.

20 Upon a proper motion we will proceed with the voice 21 vote for these nominees.

22 Senator Stabenow. So moved.

23 Chairman Roberts. All those in favor say aye.

24 [Chorus of ayes.]

25 Chairman Roberts. All those opposed say nay.

[No response.] Chairman Roberts. The ayes have it. The nominations 3 of Mr. Berkovitz and Mr. Hubbard are approved. The business meeting is now adjourned. [Whereupon, at 2:23 p.m., the Committee was adjourned.]
