1	(b) Limitations on Prescribed Burns.—
2	(1) In general.—Except as provided in para-
3	graph (2), the head of a Federal agency shall not
4	authorize a prescribed burn on Federal land if, for
5	the county or contiguous county in which the Fed-
6	eral land is located, the national fire danger rating
7	system indicates an extreme fire danger level.
8	(2) Exception.—The head of a Federal agen-
9	cy may authorize a prescribed burn under a condi-
10	tion described in paragraph (1) if the head of the
11	Federal agency coordinates with the applicable State
12	government and local fire officials.
13	(3) Report.—At the end of each fiscal year,
14	the Chief of the Forest Service shall submit to Con-
15	gress a report describing—
16	(A) the number and locations of prescribed
17	burns during that fiscal year; and
18	(B) each prescribed burn during that fiscal
19	year that was authorized by the head of a Fed-
20	eral agency pursuant to paragraph (2).
